



QCT Board Meeting, 30 July 2021:

Outcomes summary

At its fifth meeting for the year the Board:

- further considered the nature of an induction program for the new Board in 2022
- considered a request from the Department of Education regarding acceptable evidence that applications for Permission to Teach under its new 'Turn to Teaching' induction program satisfy the relevant legislative and policy requirements
- approved a policy and guideline for use in a pilot of renewal of certification as a Highly Accomplished Teacher or Lead Teacher
- gave approval for a request to be sent to the Minister for authorisation to release QCT-held teacher data for the 2021 iteration of the ATWD
- endorsed a revised 2021 budget for submission to the Minister for approval
- endorsed a report on the 2021 Board election
- noted the monthly financial performance report for June
- noted reports from the Chair and the Director, a report on the GTPA research project supported by the QCT, the half-yearly report on the QCT's compliance management, reports from QCT committees, and updates on various other activities and aspects of the QCT's work.
