



QCT Board Meeting, 25 March 2022:

Outcomes summary

At the second meeting of its new three-year term, the Board:

- appointed members as deputy chairs of QCT committees for the current Board term
 - supported a strategic approach to consider recommendations in the Report of the Quality Initial Teacher Education Review that are relevant to the work of the QCT
 - acknowledged the progress made in ITE reforms in Queensland and the work of the QCT at the national level in this area
 - delegated nominated powers of the Board and Chair under the Act to support operational decision making in the College
 - endorsed a recommendation and the next steps in implementation of a Strategic HR Review
 - endorsed the publication of an infographic that summarises data from the 2021 Annual Report
 - confirmed quality assurance principles for the graduation of final year Queensland initial teacher education students in 2022 to remain unmodified
 - supported the monthly financial report for February and the final audit report on 2021
 - acknowledged the years of service and commitment of the Principal Executive Officer who will be stepping down from the role of supporting the Board
 - noted reports from the Chair and the Director, the Registration and renewal update, the Annual Report for 2021, and reports from QCT committees.
