



QCT Board Meeting 30 November 2023:

Outcomes summary

At the sixteenth meeting of its three-year term, the Board:

- provided direction for the development of a QCT Diversity and Inclusion action plan
- endorsed a 2024 Research Plan which takes into account emerging issues and priorities in education
- approved revisions to the Conflict of Interest policy for Board and committee members
- endorsed the delegation of Board members to exercise the Board's powers for operational reasons during the summer recess period
- approved the Financial report for the month ending 31 October
- discussed the key findings from the 2023 Working for Queensland (WfQ) survey results and considered next steps for 2024
- noted the results of the stakeholder survey of the QCT's performance against objectives in QCT Strategic Plan 2023 - 2026
- reviewed progress in the evaluation of the Certification program and the direction of future work
- noted the operational review of the 2023 TEACHX Awards
- noted reports from the Chair and the Director, reports from QCT committees and updates on registration and renewals
- noted completion rates and the data release of the 2023 Australian Teacher Workforce Survey (ATWS)
