



QCT Board Meeting 20 October 2023

Outcomes summary

At the fifteenth meeting of its three-year term, the Board:

- provided direction for the development of a QCT Digital Investment strategy over the next five years to support its key functions
- endorsed the QCT Budget 2024 for submission to the Minister of Education
- endorsed the redevelopment of a case for professional experience coordination and preregistration for preservice teachers in Queensland
- endorsed timelines for the implementation of the 2024 election to appoint three practising teachers to the QCT Board
- endorsed that the Australian College of Christian Studies (ACCS) Queensland campus will be recognised as a Queensland initial teacher education (ITE) provider in meeting national ITE accreditation standards
- approved the Financial report for the month ending 31 August
- reviewed trends in ITE 2022 Program data provided to AITSL as an annual reporting requirement
- noted reports from the Chair and the Director, reports from QCT committees and updates on registration and renewals
- noted the third quarterly performance report on QCT business activities.
