



QCT Board Meeting Friday 3 May 2024:

Outcomes summary

At the nineteenth meeting of its three-year term, the Board:

- considered the findings of a QCT research partnership with Central Queensland University (CQU) about the impact of teaching under Permission To Teach on career pathways into the profession
- noted the updated Corporate Risk Register endorsed by the Audit and Risk Committee
- approved updates to a certification policy that align with the national *Framework for the Certification of Highly Accomplished and Lead Teachers*
- approved the March financial report as a true and accurate representation of the financial position and performance of the QCT for the period ending 31 March 2024
- considered key recommendations from the Non-state Schools Accreditation Framework (NSSAF) Review relevant to the QCT
- noted reporting against the QCT Business Plan 2024 and first quarter 2024
- noted the 2023 Regulatory Performance Report
- noted reports from the Chair and the Director, reports from QCT committees and updates on registration and renewals and the International Forum of Teacher Regulatory Authorities (IFTRA) June conference
