



QCT Board Meeting, 11 February 2022:

Outcomes summary

At the first meeting of its new three-year term, the Board:

- welcomed five newly appointed members
 - elected a member as deputy chairperson of the Board for the current term
 - appointed Board members to the various QCT committees for the current Board term
 - endorsed proposed actions arising from a recent Strategic Human Resources Review of the QCT Office
 - endorsed the draft QCT financial statements for 2021 for submission to the Queensland Audit Office
 - approved proposed actions regarding the Returning to Teaching professional development program to assist in addressing current workforce challenges
 - endorsed quality assurance principles for the graduation of final-year Queensland initial teacher education students in 2022 where programs may be modified due to the impacts of COVID
 - noted reports from the Chair and the Director, the closing audit report for 2021, the QCT business plan for 2022, the quarterly performance report for Q4 2021, a recent report from the Australian Teacher Workforce Data initiative, and reports from QCT committees.
