

QCT Board Meeting, 6 May 2022:

Outcomes summary

At the third meeting of its new three-year term, the Board:

- endorsed a number of strategies to support current workforce challenges that are within the scope of the QCT functions including, the development of:
 - o a communication strategy to provide information about Permission To Teach
 - o principles to support decision making about Permission To Teach
- endorsed the revised corporate risk register and a scope to review QCT's risk management framework
- recommended a re-negotiation to the proposed QCT office lease agreement
- endorsed the appointments of External Chairs of the Internal Review Committee and supported amendments to the QCT Committee Charter
- endorsed strategies to encourage greater engagement with certification and consultation about ongoing renewal processes for all certification applications
- supported the process underway for the review of the QCT Act.
