At its first meeting for the year, the newly reconstituted Board:

- supported the progression of work towards a proposed system to enable the QCT to collect data on initial teacher education students, to assist with teacher workforce planning in Queensland
- re-appointed Ms Aleisha Connellan as deputy chairperson of the Board for the 2019-2021 term of the Board
- endorsed amendments to the QCT Committee Charter
- appointed members to fill the Board member positions on QCT committees for the 2019-2021 term
- endorsed the signing of the draft QCT Financial Statements for 2018 by the Chair and Director for submission to the Queensland Audit Office
- endorsed proposed strategies to better manage and monitor the QCT's budget in 2019 and beyond
- endorsed the QCT's continuing to act as a certifying authority in Queensland for the
 Australian Institute of Teaching and School Leadership (AITSL) national certification process
 for Highly Accomplished and Lead Teachers under the QCT's function to promote the
 profession, pending an amendment to the Act to provide formal authority for the QCT to take
 on roles in voluntary teacher certification systems
- endorsed proposed strategies to counter common myths about entry requirements for initial teacher education programs
