



## **QCT Board Meeting, 12 February 2021:**

### **Outcomes summary**

At its first meeting for the year the Board:

- endorsed a QCT submission to the Australian Government on a proposed national Automatic Mutual Recognition scheme for occupational registrations
- endorsed the QCT's financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2020 for submission to the Queensland Audit Office
- endorsed a proposed timeline, Election Day and online provider for the QCT's conduct of a Board election this year
- endorsed proposals regarding this year's TEACHX Awards
- endorsed the continued exploration by the QCT Office of opportunities, issues and risks related to the establishment of sponsorship partnerships with external organisations
- commended and accepted the quarterly report on the QCT's performance for Q4 2020
- discussed the implications for new teacher quality and retention of impending changes to the offering of internships in initial teacher education programs
- noted the complexities involved in developing a policy on the renewal of certification, and endorsed the continuation of QCT work in this regard
- noted reports from the Chair and the Director, reports from QCT committees, and updates on various other activities and aspects of the QCT's work.
