## QCT Board Meeting, 26 July 2019:

## Outcomes summary

At its fifth meeting for the year, the Board:

- received a presentation by representatives from AITSL on progress with the Australian Teacher Workforce Data project
- considered the potential need, in the context of emerging teacher workforce issues, to investigate alternative models for teacher preparation and employment, and requested the QCT office to prepare a plan for a literature review and stakeholder consultation
- endorsed the format and content of a quarterly report on the QCT's performance using a range of measures for each of the five objectives of the Strategic Plan
- considered the role and work of the Professional Standards Committee from a strategic point of view
- considered an updated corporate risk register using a revised template and based on the appetite statements and revised consequence criteria agreed by the Board in 2018
- noted progress on implementation of actions arising from a review of the QCT's financial systems and processes
- received a report on the successful management of the first round of applications received by the QCT under its newly legislated function of certifying Highly Accomplished Teachers and Lead Teachers, and resolved to formally commend the QCT staff members who led this project
- considered progress with various aspects of a governance framework for the implementation of the QCT's certification function
- noted progress on the new Director's plans for her first 100 days in office
- noted updates on various other activities and aspects of the QCT's work
