QCT Board Meeting, 22 March 2019:

Outcomes summary

At the start of its second meeting for the year, the Board welcomed the Director-General, Mr Tony Cook PSM, who had been invited to speak about his priorities for the Education portfolio.

During the remainder of the meeting, the Board:

- endorsed a proposal to create stakeholder momentum in progressing the recommendations made in the QCT 2019 report Challenging Regulatory Burden
- approved an updated schedule of delegations of the Board's and the Chair's powers and a delegations policy
- appointed Dr Beedles as deputy chair of the QCT Audit and Risk Committee
- endorsed an amendment to the Committee Charter regarding the requirement for committees to have deputy chairs and endorsed an amendment to the Board Charter regarding Board proxies
- endorsed the undertaking of stakeholder consultation on how best to communicate to schools and teachers the value of supervising preservice teachers' professional experience
- endorsed an Innovation Strategy for the QCT for 2019-2020
- considered options for distribution of the outcomes of a 2018 study of attrition of early career teachers
