

## QCT Board Meeting, 1 May 2020:

## **Outcomes summary**

The Board's third ordinary meeting for the year was held using videoconferencing technology, due to the COVID-19 pandemic restrictions regarding physical distancing. The Board:

- endorsed actions taken and proposed by the QCT Office in response to emerging trends and issues related to the impact of the pandemic on the QCT
- endorsed a revised version of the Committee Charter taking in amendments to the evaluation and reporting requirements for committees and the membership of the Internal Review Committee
- approved a guideline to accompany the revised policy approved at the February 2020 meeting on 'practising teacher' Board members
- endorsed a proposal for further stakeholder consultation about the issues and considerations relating to additional pathways into the teaching profession that may be suitable in Queensland
- approved a proposal from a Queensland initial teacher education provider for a variation to professional experience arrangements for final-year preservice teachers intending to graduate in semester 1 2020
- endorsed proposed actions regarding the certification process for Highly Accomplished Teachers and Lead Teachers in 2020
- noted developments regarding moves to increase national consistency in the registration of early childhood educators
- noted reports from the Chair and Director and updates on various other activities and aspects
  of the QCT's work

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
