

QCT Board Meeting, 29 November 2019:

Outcomes summary

At its final meeting for the year, the Board:

- endorsed the continuation of planning for the marking of the fiftieth anniversary of Queensland teacher registration in 2021, including the establishment of a stakeholder reference group
- approved the 2020 QCT budget for submission to the Minister for approval
- approved the 2020 QCT Research and Data Analysis Plan
- delegated to four members exercise of the Board's powers, where necessary for operational reasons, during the summer recess
- endorsed the undertaking of initial consultation with employers to clarify the need for, and potential features of, additional ITE pathways in the Queensland context
- endorsed for sharing with stakeholders a 'report card' on the implementation to date of TEMAG reforms in Queensland
- endorsed proposed actions regarding the Highly Accomplished Teachers and Lead Teachers certification project, including the outcomes of the first round of applications, financial/funding matters, and risk management
- noted a progress report on the development of a comprehensive three-year human resources plan for the QCT
- noted progress on implementation of actions arising from a review of the QCT's financial systems and processes
- considered the role and work of the Professional Capacity and Teacher Conduct Committee from a strategic point of view
- noted updates on various other activities and aspects of the QCT's work
