

QCT Board Meeting, 19 October 2018:

Outcomes summary

At its October meeting, the Board:

- endorsed a proposed migration of the QCT's IT infrastructure to the cloud
- endorsed 'messaging concepts', about the value of teacher registration and the attractiveness of the QCT as an employer, for development into a set of images for use in QCT communications
- endorsed (i) a commercial analysis of the preferred operational model for preservice teacher registration in Queensland and (ii) the provision of a briefing note to the Minister on the final report of the analysis
- endorsed the piloting in 2019 of a new concept ('TEACHX') to replace the QCT's 10-year-old Excellence in Teaching Awards
- endorsed a draft media release to be used in conjunction with the expected future publicising by a television station of details obtained through Right to Information legislation
- considered issues arising from the future implementation of recommendation 9 of the report of the National Review of Teacher Registration
- noted updates and reports on activities and meetings of various QCT functional areas and committees
