At its sixth meeting for the year, the Board:

- endorsed the development of a reporting tool to demonstrate the QCT's performance on implementing the various reforms to initial teacher education arising from the 2014 TEMAG report

- endorsed a revised QCT 2019 budget for submission to the Minister for approval
- appointed a Board nominee to the Professional Standards Committee to replace a retiring Board member
